The Nord Center Receives \$94K for Career Training

The Nord Center was awarded \$94,600.75 from Lorain County Job and Family Services to help end the dependence on government benefits by promoting job preparation, work and marriage. Participants will acquire work experience in one of three skills training programs: clerical/computer, food service, or building trades/maintenance. Along with work experience, participants will receive job seeking skills training that includes assistance with resume writing and completing mock interviews.
