Calls are answered by our team of professionally trained and certified **Peer Support Specialists**, who have first hand experience living with a mental health condition.

How do I reach the WarmLine?

Call our Emergency/Crisis Hotline at 1.800.888.6161 and ask for the WarmLine.

When can I call?

The WarmLine operates daily from 1 pm—10 pm. (Days and times are subject to change.)

Is there a cost?

No, there is no charge for a call to the WarmLine.

What do people talk about?

Practically anything! Whether you are calling for support, need information, or just want to talk, we are here for you. WarmLine calls are confidential, so feel free to tell us what's on your mind.

Where Our Care Begins

The WarmLine is part of The Nord Center's Crisis Services program. This program offers crisis intervention services to anyone in Lorain County experiencing an emotional or psychiatric crisis.

The Nord Center accepts Medicaid, Medicare, and most major health insurances. Funds are also available for those people without insurance who qualify.
